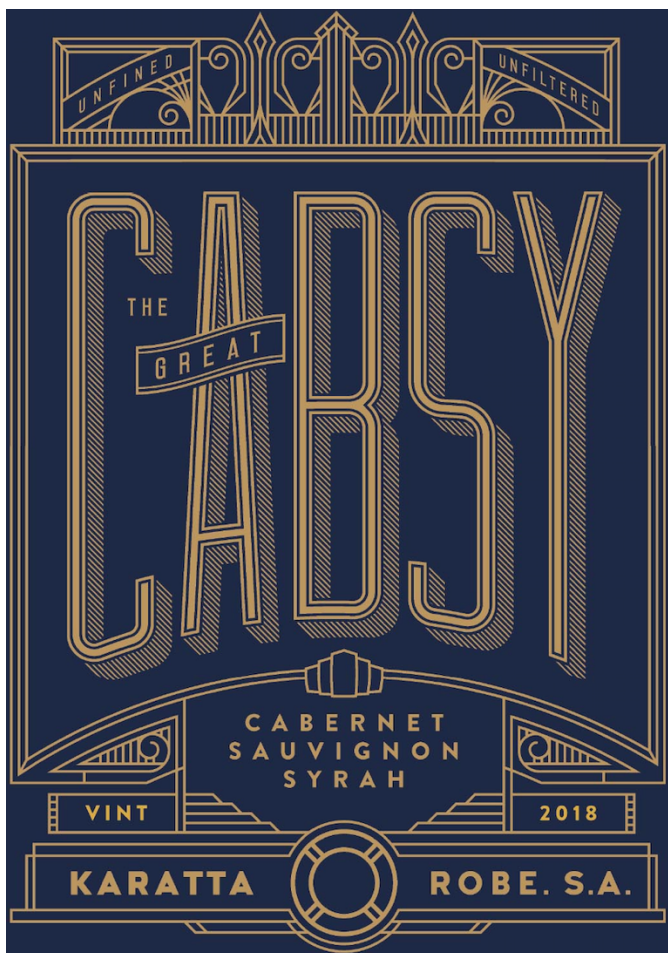


Karatta

"The Great Cabsy"



Tasting Notes:

Dried Cranberries, juicy huckleberries, tethered to earthy aromas of tomato leaf, basil, and accented with white peppercorns, anise and grippy tannins.

Production Notes:

Cabernet Sauvignon 70%, Syrah 30%

The grapes were co-fermented with wild yeast and transferred to seasoned French & American hogsheads before being racked and bottled. Unfined and unfiltered.

Karatta Wines is located in the Robe region with an extensive portfolio of estate grown wines. They are committed to the production of ready to drink and age-worthy wines that authentically reflect the maritime climate: characterized by lithe, elegant reds and crisp, snappy whites which are typically less bombastic than wines from the warmer growing regions of South Australia.
