Tasting Notes:

Bright raspberries and strawberries with notes of cotton candy and savory rhubarb.

Production Notes:

100% Pinot Noir from 25 year old vines. Dry irrigated, wild yeast ferment and aged in old oak barrels for six months before bottling.

Cellaring:

Drink now through 2023.
