Tasting Notes:

Off-dry, tropical fruits with high-acid and notes of honey.

Production Notes:

This is the only vineyard in Australia producing Kyoho! Organic practicing vineyards, hand-picked grapes, and minimal intervention winemaking. Fermentation was stopped early to allow some sweetness in the wine. The wine was left on lees for approximately 18 months to develop texture and mouth-feel. Unfined and vegan friendly. 500 cases.

About Bella Ridge:

Bella Ridge Estate is a family owned and operated vineyard and boutique winery on 25 acres in the foothills of the Darling Ranges in Western Australia's oldest wine region - the Swan Valley. All fruit is hand-picked, crushed and processed at their in-house winery.
