Tasting Notes:

Deep dark red in color this is a rich wine with intense peppery plum and coffee aromas. Loaded with chocolate and berry flavors and a subtle hint of oak. This wine lingers long and smooth on the finish.

Production Notes:

Organic practicing farming, hand-picked and naturally made. Wild ferments in small open fermenters before being transferred to French oak barrels (2-6 years old) for 36 months. Unfined, minimal filtration and minimal added Sulphur and vegan friendly! 340 cases.

About Bella Ridge:

Bella Ridge Estate is a family owned and operated vineyard and boutique winery on 25 acres in the foothills of the Darling Ranges in Western Australia's oldest wine region - the Swan Valley. All fruit is hand-picked, crushed and processed at their in-house winery. Alon and Jodi Arbel are proud to be pushing the boundaries, producing handcrafted blends and styles that are flavorsome, innovative and distinctive.

- Swan Valley's first vines were planted in 1829.

- For at least 40,000 years, the Nyoongar Aboriginal people from the Wadjuk tribe have inhabited the region believing Wagyl – a Dreamtime serpent – travelled across the country to carve both the Swan Valley and the Swan River.
