A heady perfume of primary fruits, dried cranberries, cherries and freshly ground spices. Intriguing and beguiling. Concentrated and dense, but light bodied. The fruit flavors are layered with spices and framed with silky tannins.

Production Notes: 100% Pinot Meunier

Best's Pinot Meunier Vineyards were planted in 1868 and this wine is made only in the best vintages. The grapes are handpicked, hand sorted and hand plunged in open vats and aged in French oak barrels. the ultimate wine that speaks of place and it has a cult following, particularly in the wine community and the trade where people understand how rare this varietal planting is.
