Tasting Notes:

FUN! Explosive aromas of nectarine, pear and grape, honey and frangipani. Gently sweet, the freshness of the wine is important in keeping it light and balanced.

Production Notes:

97% Muscat Blanc a Petits Grains, 3% Montepulciano

From Ricca Terra Farms' Barmera vineyard, sandy loam over clay. Made as a classic Moscato, with montepulciano for pretty pink color. Stainless steel ferment and aging, no oak. Bottled young. Sterile fining and filtration before bottling. 7% abv. 90g/L residual sugar. 2,000 cases made.

About Prometheus:

A hand crafted range of single vineyard wines made by an eclectic group of friends. These varieties are often found in Mediterranean climates, but are perfectly suited to the Riverland. With a hands off approach to the winemaking and emphasis on fruit purity, they're certain you will love drinking them as much as they loved creating them.
