Tasting Notes:

Bright, fresh, and with a savory edge. Perfect vibe between complex and subtle. It's the textured effervescence that excites the palate leaving gripping umami notes, forcing you to come back for more.

Production Notes:

100% Pinot Noir

Hand-picked from the sustainably-farmed Nine One Six vineyard in the Steels Creek region in Yarra Valley. Wild fermented in old French barriques, with 6 months on lees. Secondary fermentation in bottle. Undisgorged, unfined, unfiltered, and zero added sulfur.

Cellaring:

It's called Blanc de Now for a reason. Drink it!

"What drives me every day is the connection with place, and its interpretation through winemaking." -Ben Haines Ben's wines are intensely textural with flavors continuing to develop sip after sip. The fruit is expressive and the structure is present without being constraining.
