'Lost Ram' Shiraz

Tasting Notes:

The Lost Ram is a bright, generous but soft style of wine. Bottled in the same year of harvest to preserve its fresh, youthful fruit characters. Elegant, vibrant and expressive. Silky, grippy fine tannins. Even and smooth, with red and black fruits, cocoa powder, almond skin.

Production Notes:

100% Syrah from a 30 year old vineyard on sandy loam soils. Hand harvested, 20% whole bunches in the ferment. Aged for 10 months in old French oak (no new). Unfined, filtered only in terms of straining out any wayward insects. 28ppm free SO2. 500dz made.

Cellaring:

Drink now through 2028.

Karatta Wines is located in the Robe region with an extensive portfolio of estate grown wines. They are committed to the production of ready to drink and age-worthy wines that authentically reflect the maritime climate: characterized by lithe, elegant reds and crisp, snappy whites which are typically less bombastic than wines from the warmer growing regions of South Australia.
