

Point Ormond Cabernet Sauvignon

Tasting Notes:

Rich flavors of cassis, blueberry and chocolate lead to a medium body with leafy, tobacco-like layers and fine grained, supple tannins.

Production Notes:

The vibrant aromas and distinctive fruit flavors were carefully preserved by harvesting in the cool morning hours during autumn. The wine was fermented in separate batches and blended together after several months on French oak prior to bottling.

About Point Ormond:

Point Ormond is everything that's exciting about Australian wine today: delicious, high acid, not big on the alcohol, versatile, bursting with personality, sometimes quirky, and always affordable. In a nutshell: these tasty wines hugely over-deliver for their price.

The wines are an exploration of vineyard sites around Australia, with a slight bias toward the state of Victoria, undoubtedly Australia's food and wine capital. Vines are grown with the utmost respect to the surrounding environment.

Cellaring:

Ready to enjoy now, although this wine will gain complexity over the next three to five years with careful cellaring.
