Tasting Notes:

A fresh and crisp Semillon, with undertones of lemon sherbet and citrus fruit. The palate is clean and complex with a stunning lime finish. Classic Hunter Valley .

Production Notes:

Sourced from 40+ year old vines in the Hordem and Dalwood vineyards. Both fermentation and aging take place in stainless-steel tanks

About Kirkton Estate:

Kirkton Estate was the first vineyard to be established in the Hunter Valley by John Busby in 1830. Kirkton’s historic importance grew from its intrinsic association with James Busby, (son of John Busby) and its role in being the incubator for what remains the largest and most diverse viticulture assessment project undertaken in Australia.
